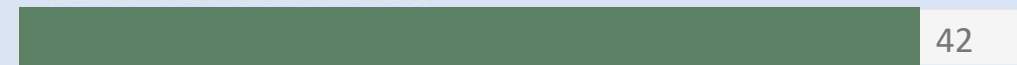

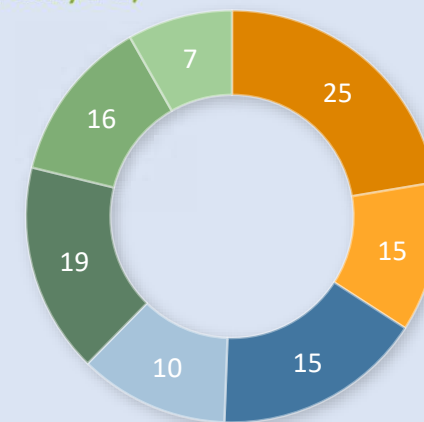

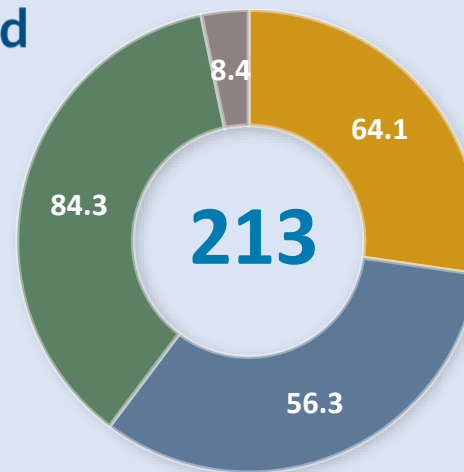

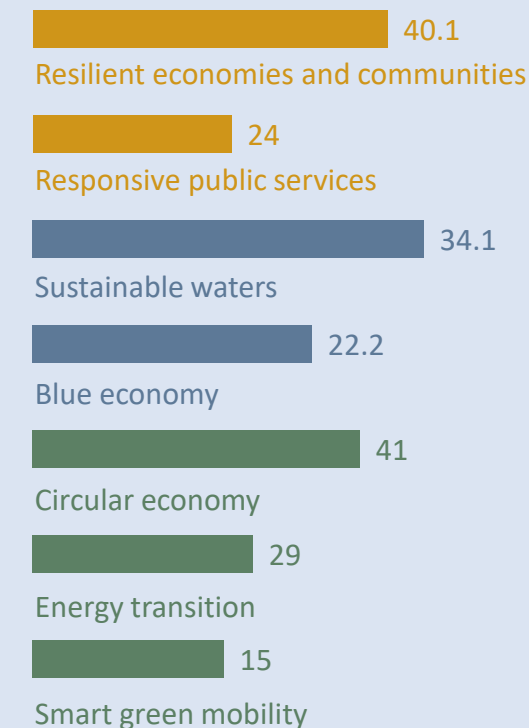

ERDF funds committed by objective

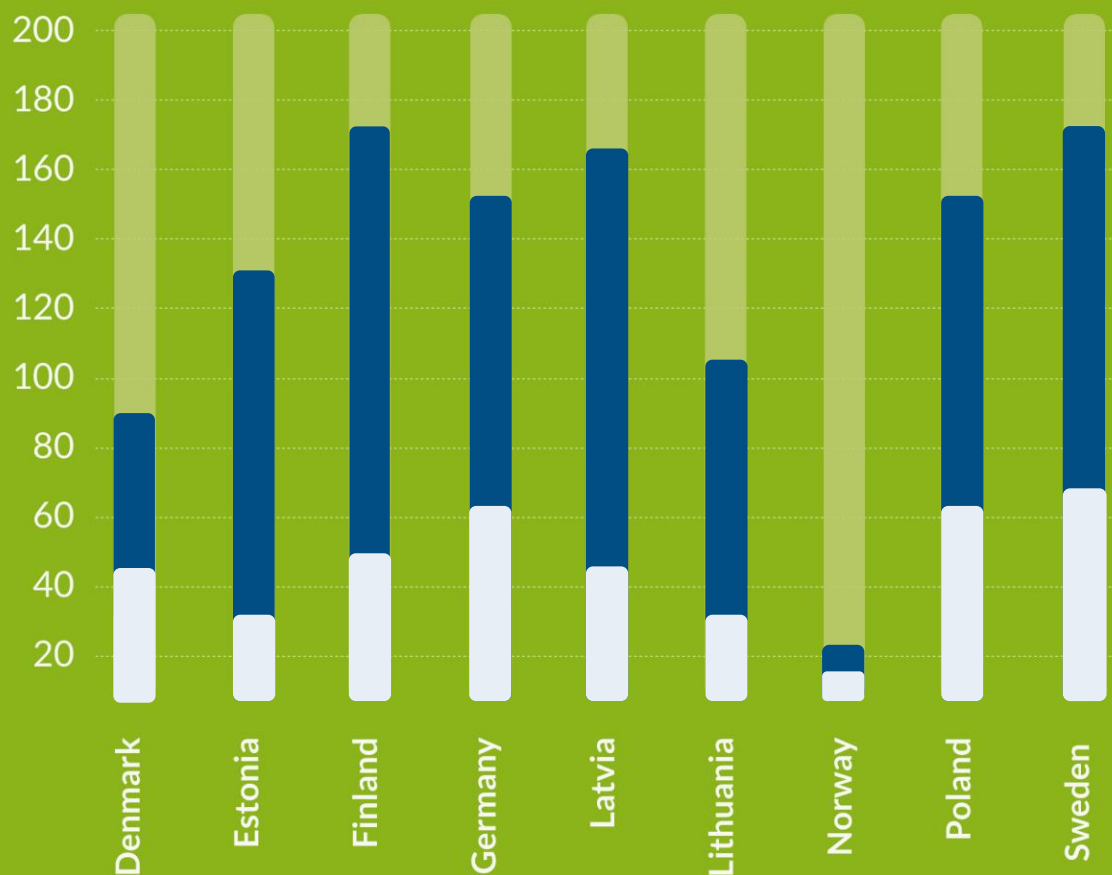

Partners per country

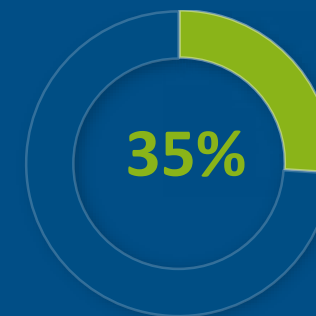

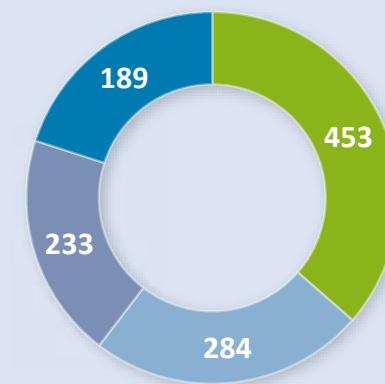

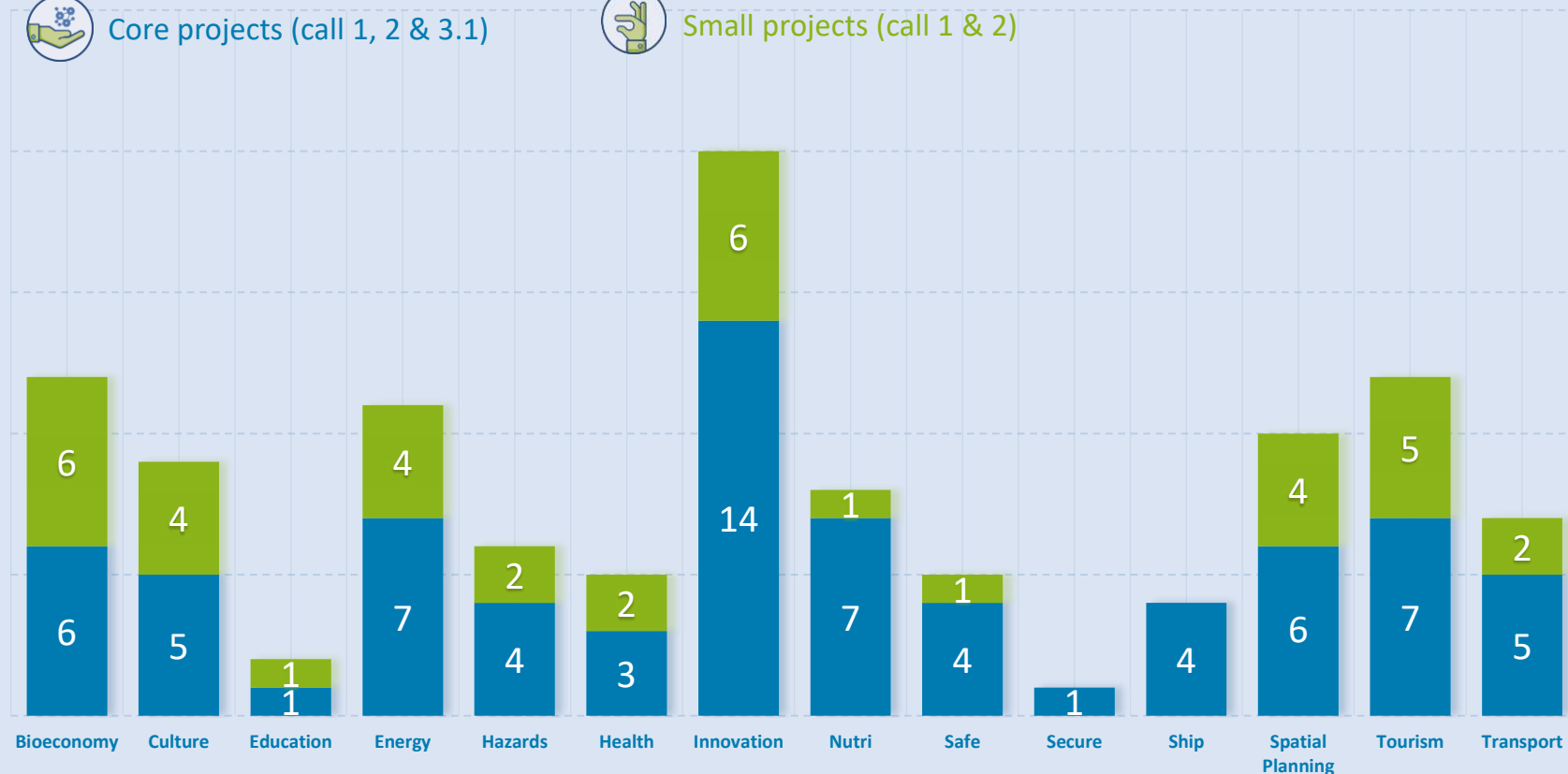
